May 9th, 2008 - The Hutchinson BioTech scholarship fund for class of 2009 high school students has received renewed funding, allowing Hutchinson BioTech to offer full scholarships to 350 students for the eighth consecutive year. The 350 competitive and need-based scholarships are available to any 12th grade students with an interest in pursuing post-secondary education in the fields of science or engineering.

Applicants shall include a 500-word essay discussing the student's desire to pursue a degree in the qualifying fields. Please note we also require copies of the students' transcript and birth certificate for administrative purposes.

Of the applicants, 600 students will be selected as finalists. Students selected as finalists will be contacted with more information regarding the award process and an interview with the applicant will be scheduled to assist in the determination of those who will receive the scholarships.
